# The NIH Public Access Policy



- The <u>NIH public access policy</u> applies to NIH funded papers that have been published, or accepted for publication, in a peer-reviewed journal, on or after April 7, 2008.
- To advance science and improve human health, the policy requires scientists to make the results of their published NIH-funded research available on PubMed Central (PMC).
- Determine if your paper falls under the public access policy and how to comply <u>http://publicaccess.nih.gov/determine-applicability.htm</u>.

1. When preparing a manuscript	Ensure you retain the legal rights to comply with public access
2. When the manuscript is accepted for publication	Post it to PubMed Central and track it with My NCBI
3. When reporting the paper to NIH	Include the PMCID in the citation; see how to cite here

### How to Correct Non-Compliant Papers

Submit\_your paper or check the status in <u>NIHMS</u>. Ensure <u>steps</u> are completed to obtain compliance. Provide evidence of compliance with a PDF report or a Progress Report Additional Material (PRAM).

### **Helpful Hints for Non-Compliant Papers**

#### A <u>PMCID</u> provides evidence of compliance. Include the PMCID when citing your paper. A PMCID is not the same as a PMID.

□ What's the difference? PMID, PMCID, NIHMSID?

- Anyone submitting an application, proposal or report to the NIH must include the PMCID when citing applicable papers that they author or that arise from their NIH-funded research.
- Avoid possible delays in processing your award. Ensure your submitted paper is compliant and receives a PMCID in a timely manner.

## An NIHMSID reference number is assigned when you deposit your paper via the NIHMS system.

□ The NIHMSID may or may not provide temporary/provisional compliance.

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
